General Guidelines For Admission

- 1) Admission to all class and courses are strictly provisional and will be confirmed only after receiving the necessary approval of the respective authority.
- 2) Admission to the college is on the basis of merit.
- 3) Only those applications who fulfill all the eligibility conditions laid down by the authority will be considered for admission.
- 4) In case the students have a problem regarding selection of subjects details to be filled in the form, they are advised to seek the help of the admission committee.
- 5) The right of granting admission to any courses is reserved with the authorities of the college.
- 6) It is necessary to take counter sign from the education Director on LC who come from other divisional board and other district.

Documents Required For Admission

- 1) 5 passport size recent Photograph.
- 2) Students from other colleges seeking admission must submit the original copies of the leaving certificate and mark sheet along with 4 attested xerox copies.
- 3) Students from other board (ex. CBSE / ICSE) will have to submit migration certificate and mark sheet in original, authenticated by respective regional authority of board of education along with 4 xerox copies of the same.
- 4) Caste Certificate (If applicable)
- 5) Student Adhar Card Xerox.

Please Note

- 1) The original school leaving certificate of last school/college attend will not be returned to the students under any circumstance.
- 2) Admission will not be given without submission of school leaving certificate in the Original & without parents.



3) Scholarship, freeship form will be accepted at the time of admission only. These forms should be properly filled in and submitted to the office at the time of admission.

It is the responsibility of the concerned students to see the forms are complete in all respects.

Discipline In The Library

- 1) Strictly observe the rules and regulations at the library.
- 2) Use Library books with great care.
- 3) Do not scribble anything on the books borrowed from the library.
- 4) Never fail to return the books on the due date.
- 5) Tearing of papers or damaging the library will result in the disciplinary action.
- 6) Maintain absolute silence in the study room.
- 7) The students are allowed to keep a book for eight days only. Failing to do so a fine of Rs. 5/- per day will be charged for fifteen (15) days after the due date later fine of Rs. 25/- per day will be charged till the book is returned. In case of any problem consult librarian.

Discipline In The Laboratory

- 1) Maintain discipline in the laboratory.
- 2) Handle the equipments with great care failing to do so a breakage charge of equipment will be taken by students.
- 3) Negligence at any kind will invite due action.
- 4) Maintain your journal.
- 5) While handling materials like acids, electrical equipments etc. Student should take all necessary precaution.
- 6) In case you have any difficulty consult the instructor.
- 7) Help to keep your laboratory clean.
- 8) Use apron, when you are in laboratory.



Discipline In The Class Room

- 1) Attendance is compulsory. As per the directive at the high court and the ordinance of the Pune board 80% attendance is compulsory for a students to be eligible to appear for Annual Examination conducted by the (HSC) Board.
- 2) Observe the rules and regulation regarding internal test, seminars, home assignments etc.
- 3) Extend full co-operation to the teacher.
- 4) Feel free to discuss your difficulties with the teachers at the appropriate time.
- 5) Help to Maintain discipline in the class room.
- 6) Do not scribble any thing on the wall, desk and black board.
- 7) Help to keep the classroom clean.



General Instruction :

- 1) Maintain discipline in the campus, keep your identity card always with you for inspection as and when asked for.
- 2) Park your cycle/vehicle at the notified parking place.
- 3) Regard and use college property building, furniture, trees, books, etc. with care as if it is your own property.

- 12) Take care to fill in the examination form as per schedule.
- 13) Make it a point to see all notice boards every day for relevant information and Instruction regarding curricular and extra Curricular activities, scholarship, examination etc.



- 15) Desist from asking for out of turn favours.
- 16) As per the order of Honorable supreme of Indian, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of authority, the concerned students shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him / her from the institution.
